*Not all inspections listed may be required.

PROJECTS MAY REQUIRE PLANNING BOARD APPROVAL PRIOR TO BUILDING PERMIT SUBMITTAL.

Required Construction Documents for Submittal: Digitally or electronically signed and sealed drawings – (Visit the Online Permitting Resource Center link noted above for instructions).

Construction Documents	Department Review
☐ Site Survey Signed & Sealed Topographic/Boundary Survey	Planning
☐ Dimensional plan which shows steps, doorway clear opening and dimensions in restrooms and kitchen (for ADA compliance check). May use the most recent Building Permit on file as a reference set for the review	Building, Electrical, Fire, Mechanical, Planning, Plumbing, Structural

*Plans must include:

- 1. Clear scope of work detailing (Demolition, Architectural, Electrical, Plumbing, and Mechanical) there should be no work required. For any required construction work, an alteration permit will be needed.
- 2. Specific Occupancy as classified in Chapter 3 of the Florida Building Code. If Mixed Occupancy, the floors and areas of each occupancy must be identified.
- 3. The exact number of units in the building, whether it is a Hotel, Resort-Condo, Apartments, Offices, Mercantile spaces, etc.
- No contractor or Design professional is needed on this permit.
