Important Updates on Vote-by-Mail Procedures for Miami Beach Elections

We want to ensure you are informed and ready to participate in the upcoming Miami Beach elections, which will be held as follows:

- **General Election:** Tuesday, November 4, 2025
- **Run-Off Election (if required):** Tuesday, December 9, 2025

Important Notice About Florida's Voting Laws

Florida's voting laws have recently changed, and your action may be required to ensure you receive a Vote-by-Mail ballot.

Important Changes to Vote-by-Mail Requests

Florida law now requires a hard reset of all Vote-by-Mail enrollments after the November 2022 General Election. This means:

- All previous Vote-by-Mail requests expired on December 31, 2024.
- To Vote-by-mail in any election between January 1, 2025, and December 31, 2026, you must submit a new request.
- The deadline to request a Vote-by-Mail ballot is 5 p.m., 12 days before election day.

Election Date	Last Date to Request a Vote-by-Mail Ballot
General Election: 11.04.25	10.23.25
Run-Off Election: 12.09.25	11.27.25

How to Request Your Vote-by-Mail Ballot

You can request your Vote-by-Mail ballot using the following methods:

- **Online:** Visit your local Supervisor of Elections website at https://www.miamidade.gov/global/service.page?Mduid_service=ser1482258761076685
- **By Phone:** Contact your local elections office at 305-499-VOTE (8683)
- **In Person:** Visit your Supervisor of Elections office at 2700 NW 87 Avenue, Miami, FL 33172

When submitting your request, be prepared to provide your:

1. Full name and date of birth.
2. Florida driver's license number or the last four digits of your Social Security number.

Accessible Voting Options

- Voters with disabilities can request accessible Vote-by-Mail ballots.

- Information is available in multiple languages, including English, Spanish and Haitian Creole.

- Check the City's or Supervisor of Elections website regularly for updates. The City's website is votemiamibeach.com, and the Election Department's website is amelectionready.com.
- Follow your elections office on social media for reminders and deadlines.
