SUBJECT: Attendance at City-Sponsored Senior Events

On May 21, 2025, the Mayor and City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2025-33670, which clarifies and amends the rules governing attendance at City-sponsored senior events, as initially established in Resolution No. 2024-33134.

The present rule is as follows:

- Only elected officials and individuals who have officially registered as candidates may attend City-sponsored senior events in a campaign-related capacity.
- Each elected official or registered candidate may bring one guest.
- Campaign materials, promotional items, or written materials may not be distributed inside the event space.
- The City will provide designated tables outside the event space where campaign materials may be placed for attendees to review or take voluntarily.
- Individuals who are not officially registered as candidates may not attend these events in a campaign-related role, even if they are considering seeking office.

This rule applies to all major senior events hosted by the City, including the Senior Holiday Party, Senior Prom, Senior Summer Bash, and Senior Police Ball.
